#### T.J.'s Tips

When assembling a balsa wood model, sometimes we end up with an undesirable gap between 2 pieces. Household baking soda and thin CA can make an excellent filler for this issue. The left container is a repurposed squeeze bottle used to dispense the baking soda. Fill the gap with baking soda, wipe off the excess with your finger or whatever is appropriate, and drip thin CA on the joint. The baking soda seems to set off the CA quite quickly, so make sure the parts are where you want them before dripping on the CA. The CA will make a hard point versus the surrounding balsa wood - - so be careful sanding the joint.




